

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), MOBW Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 790 Wallace Road RD 3 Cambridge 3495 and known as MONAVALÉ BLUEBERRIES REMOTE SALES, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Alcohol may be sold or supplied at any time, on any day, while always trading as a remote seller.
- (b) Alcohol must not be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day, or between 11:00pm and 6:00am the following day.
- (c) The licensed premises is described in the plan date stamped as received by the Waipa District Licensing Committee on 23 November 2018.
- (d) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer (and if applicable, the receiver) is not under the purchase age. The licensee must ensure that the sale will not be made unless the buyer (and if applicable, the receiver) completes a declaration that they are 18 years of age or over.
- (e) There must be no delivery of alcohol to minors or intoxicated persons and there must be displayed on the MOBW Limited internet site in a prominent place appropriate signs detailing these restrictions.
- (f) The outside of every delivery package made by remote sale must contain the following words:

COURIER WARNING

- 1. Do not leave at destination without proof of delivery.
- 2. Do not leave with persons under 18 years of age. If the receiver appears to be under the age of 25 years check valid identification such as current passport, driver licence or Hospitality NZ 18+ Card Evidence of Age Document to ensure the receiver is 18 years of age or over.
- 3. Do not leave with intoxicated persons.
- 4. Contains alcoholic product.

- (g) A copy of the licence must be displayed on the Monavale Blueberries Remote Sales internet site in a prominent place.
- (h) Every receipt for the sale of alcohol by remote sale must contain the licence holder's name, licence number and the date on which the licence expires.

Duration

- i) Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force **until the expiry date shown at the bottom of this licence.**
- ii) If an application for the renewal of the licence is made in accordance with the Act before the licence expires, the licence will remain in force until that renewal application is determined (provided it is determined before the next anniversary of the licence).
- iii) If the licence is renewed, a replacement licence will be issued with an amended expiry date.
- iv) This licence automatically expires if a licence of the same type is issued in respect to the same licensed premises (i.e. to a new operator).
